  - Can edit videos, audios and photo
  - Beyond capability of canva, needed for lookbook
  - Is usually 60/month but student is 20
- Beyond lookbook use for creative cloud
  - Use for photoshoots and magazine photoshoots
  - Money already allocated for magazine
- For magazine, what is used?
  - Not sure, magazine uses their own software
- Discussion
  - The show is already funded, can you fund creative cloud again?
    - Argument for both
  - How are they making magazine
    - Using canva
  - Going into debt before show
  - They only asked for food
  - It's not a physical/capital investment, only lasts for 6 months
  - Could be useful, intrinsic to function
