## Notes:

$\rightarrow$ 1st idea: set of provisioning that only apply until the end of the school year due to budget shortfalls

- Ceases to exist by end of year
- Message to RSOs to be self-limiting
- Unless limiting amount of funding, no need for this
- Fundraising requirements for size of request rather than number of requests
- Sgfc shouldn't have same levels of these requirements
- Ideas:
- $10 \%$ fundraising min for over $\$ 3 k, 25 \%$ for over $\$ 10 k$
- Is a recommendation not a strict requirement
- Anything over \$1500-10\% >
- Sgfc won't fund events that haven't occurred in prior years/had funding
- Point of annual allocations is to fund events that haven't happened
- There might be events that SGFC can't fund since they'll run out of money > SGFC has discretion to not fund events that it doesn't deem fulfilling/contributing to campus life
- But SGFC tries not to make subjective decisions but maybe there should be an objective way to do so
- CC made point about concerns about events that admissions props up as uchicago experience
- Might have to refuse funding for newer/less known events
$\rightarrow$ 50/33 > 40/25
- Cost guided travel downgrade
$\rightarrow$ General cost principles
- Sgfc may discount options when they are
- No mechanism at the moment to cost guide RSOs
- What does this look like:
- When they quote items but a cheaper alt is found
$\rightarrow$ \$1k/yr > \$200/quarter/RSO
- Encourages RSOs to hold more fundraisers throughout the year
- Decreases avg amount slightly unless RSOs come with multiple funding requests
- There is exception for newer RSOs
- Only restriction at the moment is cap of $\$ 1 \mathrm{k} / \mathrm{yr}$
$\rightarrow$ RSOs expected to show retention/attendance through RSVP/attendance forms
- If they provide speculative numbers, this can help cut down
- Events where they have 20 active members, if they have 50 ppl for event > there should be a discrepancy for events and number of people who are active members
- Would have to check on RSO's activeness amongst their members
- Requests for RSVP attendance sign up sheet
- Help with considering cases where attendance from last year has drastically increased
$\rightarrow$ Restricting graduate RSOs
- No way of knowing the complete makeup of grad/undergrad numbers
- Funding from sgfc comes from student service fee that undergrads pay but grads don't pay
$\rightarrow$ advertising/printing
- Change: Print publicity is 1 color print/2 attendee, $0.25 / 2$ attendee
- Max: $\$ 100$ for social media publicity is a little high
- Separating printing and social media > small events don't need social media publicity as much
- Cut social media line item
- If RSO comes with request, could lump sum/make an exception
$\rightarrow$ Added to section 6: publication RSOs have to justify \# of prints they need
$\rightarrow$ Decor for events
- Change to per person, done similarly to social media/publicity
- Expectation that RSOs must break down item by item of their decorations
$\rightarrow$ Food
- 1st change: decreasing breakfast to max $\$ 2$
- Most events don't need breakfast
- For cultural events
- $15 /$ person $>$ increase up to $25 \%$
- Cultural desserts
- RSOs serving snacks so reduces funding
$\rightarrow$ SGFC may limit food funding if food isn't necessary for function
- Food for general meeting is okay
- Exceptions:
- Cultural events
- Events exceeding 5 hours
- Out of town trips
- Not for events such as a movie night where pizza is requested for 12/person
- Call for SGFC to cut on food funding because it's the biggest
$\rightarrow$ SGFC may have food funding with exceptions due to budget
$\rightarrow$ Funding requests must have item/item breakdown
$\rightarrow$ SGFC will likely not fund event that's sole purpose is to provide food
- Already mentioned in guidelines
$\rightarrow$ utensils/plates bracket will be $\$ 50$ for utensil, $0.60 /$ person
$\rightarrow$ Hotel accommodations
$\checkmark$ From precedent, not funding airport to school cabs - unless exceptional instances
$\rightarrow$ SGFC will only fund 1 student travel requests
- For the rest of this year
$\rightarrow$ SGFc will not fund current students who are performers
- Extends to Phd students
$\rightarrow 500$ or more is discouraged but open to reviewing
- Letting RSOs know
- Every time there's an honorarium
- But more can be funded
$\rightarrow$ Subscriptions
- Websites
- 4/month - base level
- Usually funding websites
- Need to justify and if design is an essential part of club

- Fundraising from singing valentines goes to other RSO costs and not album recording

- Usually raise 1500 for valentines event
- Any funding for album in previous years?
- no
- Have you tried to lower fundraising efforts?
- Typically, started doing them in person
- Annual 1500-2k
- A lot of funds go to annual running costs due to low allocations
- For line costs, where does money go towards
- Recording in logan so no recording fee
- But all goes to engineer working with them
- For quote, 3225, is that going towards the producer just producing or is he also singing + producing?
- Will's quote is going towards engineering work, $75 / \mathrm{hr}$
- Others are $120 / \mathrm{hr}$
- Discussion
- SGFC policy: Expect 50\% funding for album
- Can't fund it, they haven't fundraised any money so far
- The fundraised money wouldn't go to album if it had been fundraised
- Could be SGFC error for making them come twice
- Told them to come back because request wasn't itemized
- SGFC missed the cost guideline on fundraising expectation as well as Cadenza
- SGFC didn't ask about fundraising last week
- Cadenza was asked to come back because they didn't have a lot of information about their request
- SGFC now knows they haven't fundraised for it
- Unless there's substantial reason to go against what is generally required, it shouldn't happen
- If funding $50 \%$, funded money wouldn't be enough for them
- But expectation is that they funded $50 \%$ but they don't have the other half if the half from SGFC is granted
- Wouldn't be able to fund the needs of RSO
- Motion to... not fund on basis that half of costs for album has not been fundraised and based on guidelines, rso must fundraise half
